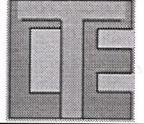

- 2) Physical verification of the vehicle shall be done by the Institute, if deemed necessary, before paying TA.
- 3) If travelled by ordinary bus/luxury bus/railway, the actual fare will be reimbursed on production of tickets. However, if the ticket is not attached, then ordinary bus fare will be reimbursed.
- 4) If travelled by hired vehicle/taxi, the travelling allowance will be given based on actual kms as per the rates mentioned above and not as per the actual fare of taxi.
- 5) The local conveyance for travel between Railway station/Bus station and the Institute will be paid as per actual but maximum up to Rs. 300/-per day (to and fro) only to those examiners who have travelled by bus/rail.
- 6) For calculating the travelled kilometres during non-vacation period, the starting point will be the Institute where the examiner is employed. However, the distance between the place of residence and the Institute shall be considered for payment of TA during vacation period. The proof of vacation period must be attached by the examiner.

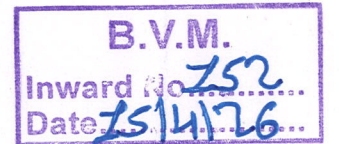

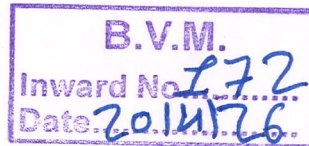

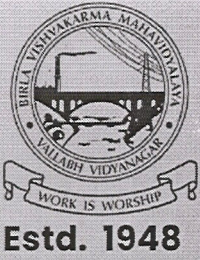
