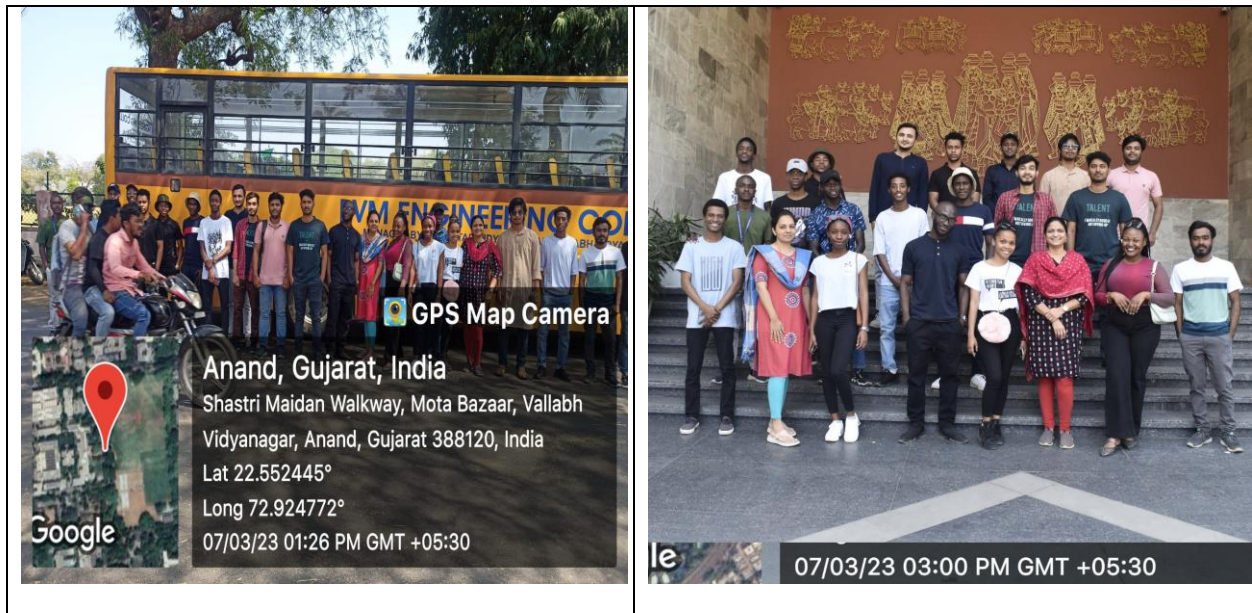


A Report on Industrial Visit to Amul Dairy Plant by ICCR Students and Request for Transportation
